## Student Council Announces: Christian Academy FAIR Theme

This year the Christian Academy student council has voted to host a **FAIR** themed homecoming. The homecoming court, including homecoming king and queen, will be announced at the homecoming game on **Friday, January 25<sup>th</sup>** during the half-time of the boys' varsity basketball game.

The chapel dress/formal event will take place on **January 26<sup>th</sup>**. Tickets will cost **\$20 presale, \$25** at the door and went on sale on **January 3<sup>rd</sup>**. The students should arrive at **6:30 p.m.** where they will enjoy fair food, a coffee bar, fair games, competitions, and a prize auction using "fair bucks" earned throughout the night. The days leading up to homecoming will be full of celebration.

- **Monday, January 21<sup>st</sup>** - No school (**School open to decorate homeroom doors from 12 p.m. -2 p.m. student council decorating 10 a.m. -2 p.m.**)
- **Tuesday, January 22<sup>nd</sup>** - "On the Farm" Dress Up Day (dress code applies, exceptions can be made for hats if not distracting in classes, **no full cow suits, or masks please**)
- **Wednesday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>** - **NO CHAPEL DRESS NEEDED FOR K-12** (Because it's Homecoming Week!). Popcorn will be served at lunch
- **Thursday, January 24<sup>th</sup>** - Class Door Decorating Competition (must be complete for judging at noon)
- **Friday, January 25<sup>th</sup>** - CAS Spirit Day/Pep Rally wear your CAS gear and colors. This year we are allowing 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grades reasonable CAS color **face** paint (Blue, Gray and White) and **washable hair color** (Blue, Gray and White) that will be washed out by the time you come to Homecoming on the 26<sup>th</sup> (if you are coming) or school on the 28<sup>nd</sup> (if not going to homecoming). We could make this a fun tradition at CAS if these standards are followed.
- **Friday, January 25<sup>th</sup>** - Homecoming Basketball Games (court announced at half-time of varsity boys' game)

We are asking that if a High School has a guest that the guest be between 9<sup>th</sup> grade and 21 years of age. *\*Note: students that want to bring a guest need to get a form and approval from Mr. K by Wednesday January 23<sup>rd</sup>.*

### Shelby County Community Foundation

CAS seniors and graduates are eligible for scholarships administered by the Community Foundation of Shelby County. Apply online at [www.commfoun.com](http://www.commfoun.com). Click Scholarships! on the home page or go to the Receive tab and select Scholarships. From the dropdown menu, pick the Christian Academy application. You can create an account that lets you complete an application over several sessions. Go to the 'Scholarships FAQs' page or contact the foundation office at [info@commfoun.com](mailto:info@commfoun.com) or 497-7800 if you need help completing the application or attaching documents. Section 8 of the application shows all scholarships available to Christian Academy students and alumni through the Community Foundation. Click 'Yes' in front of any scholarships for which you are eligible and want to be considered. **Most of the high school senior scholarships deadline is Thursday, February 14<sup>th</sup> and most current college or adult student scholarships deadline is Monday, May 30<sup>th</sup>.** You will need to attach your transcript and, in most cases, your FAFSA EFC number, write a brief personal statement and line up letters of recommendation. **DON'T WAIT...APPLY NOW!**

Local dentists will be screening students identified by the school nurse at the Compassionate Care facility located at 124 N. Ohio St. If the child needs follow-up treatment, the local dentists have agreed to provide treatment for the next 6 months at NO CHARGE.
